1st prize - € 3000,00* scholarship, Caript Award and Certificate *The winner will receive a € 2250,00 prize by bank transfer and € 750,00 as reimbursement for two concerts organized by the Rospigliosi Association and Amici Dell'Opera di Pistoia

2nd prize - € 1200,00* scholarship, Caript Award and Certificate * The winner of the second scholarship will receive € 850,00 of prize by bank transfer and € 350,00 as reimbursement of expenses for a concert by the Rospigliosi Association performance at "Sala Polivalente San Antonio" - Marina di Pietrasanta (Lucca)

3rd prize - € 500,00 scholarship, Caript Award and Certificate

- During the awards ceremony on **3 April**, the audience will award the best performance (Plaque and Certificate)

During the final evening of the Schumann Prize, the "**Young Musicians Award**" will be presented, voted on by a jury composed of students from the Music High School and middle schools with a musical major. These young musicians in training, actively participating as jurors, will award the prize, providing a youthful perspective on the performances and having the opportunity to compare their evaluations with those of the jury composed of expert and renowned musicians.
